These proposals were referred to the Desk Appraisal Team (DAT) of KEA. The DAT has gone through the details furnished for each criterion supported by the documents. These were examined with reference to

para (2) and (3) of Expression of Interest document, to assess whether they fulfill the eligibility and essential eligibility criteria. DAT has prepared a detailed statement enclosed as Annexure-I showing marks scored by these CO's out of 250 marks for the above appraisals and as per the above statement, Consultant Organizations have scored more than 125 marks as per eligibility to get empanelment.

Hence the COs were called to make Power Point Presentations of their achievements, credentials, experience, and exposure to various sectors before the members of empanelment committee through virtual mode. Accordingly, they made the presentation.


