For reconstitution of Karnataka State Policy and Planning Commission on the lines of NITI Aayog, Planning, Programme Monitoring and Statistics Department has issued G.O. no. PDS 47 SPB 2021, Bangalore, dated: 06-08-2022 copy enclosed as *Annexure-IV*. As per G.O. Karnataka Evaluation Authority shall be renamed as Karnataka Monitoring and Evaluation Authority (KMEA) on the lines of Development Monitoring and Evaluation Office (DMEO) of NITI Aayog.

Meeting was held on 12-10-2022 under the Chairpersonship of the Addl. Chief Secretary to Govt., Planning, Programme Monitoring and Statistics Department to merge various divisions under State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka (SITK), the Chairman directed that Karnataka Evaluation Authority shall be renamed as Karnataka Monitoring and Evaluation Authority (KMEA) with SITK on the lines of Development Monitoring and Evaluation Office (DMEO) of NITI Aayog.

Hence, necessary action has to be taken to change the present name of Karnataka Evaluation Authority as Karnataka Monitoring and Evaluation Authority. The subject is placed before this Governing Body of KEA for kind approval.

Karnataka Evaluation Authority has a target to conduct at least 20-30 evaluations of Govt., schemes/Programmes every year. During the process of every evaluation, various reports (Inception Report, Interim report, Draft Evaluation Report, Sample Report and Final Report) will be received in KEA both in English and Kannada version for approval. The copy of the Final Evaluation Report (FER) which will be submitted to the concerned departments and others concerned will be maintained in KEA Library for future reference. But due to lack of space, other reports (other than FER) and documents could not be maintained.

Further, for conducting evaluation studies, KEA empanelled Evaluation Consultant Organisations will be selected under QCBS method of KTPP Act. During the course of empanelment and tender process various documents and reports will be received in KEA.

Hence, it is requested to discard the other reports and documents (other than Sample FER and FER) received during the Evaluation process, empanelment process, tender process, etc., which are older than 5 years ie., before 2018-19.



PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Subject: Restructuring Karnataka State Policy and Planning Commission on the lines of NITI Aayog.

Reference: 1. NITI Aayog's Letter No: M-13040/44/2018-S-Co, dated 28.01.2019.

 Cabinet Case No:C:365/2022, Hon'ble Chief Minister's approved note dated 4.8.2022.

Proposal

In the letter referenced (1) above, NITI Aayog of the Government of India in its meeting with the secretaries of the Planning Department and In-Charge Planning Boards of the States/UTs has proposed converting State Planning Board to a State Level Think Tank, for Policy Formulation at State Level. In this regard, the Karnataka State Policy and Planning Commission (KSPPC) has decided to reconstitute on the recommendation of the NITI Aayog (National Institution for Transforming India -NITI). A proposal for the reconstitution of State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka (SITK) on the line of NITI Aayog has been prepared.

As per proposed organizational structure, Hon'ble Chief Minister will be the Chairman of the SITK, and an expert in government planning and related matters will be nominated by the Government as the Vice-Chairman. On the lines of NITI Aayog's focus on Sustainable Development Goals-2030 and India @ 2047, SITK to focus on 8 sectors viz., (1) Education, (2) Health and Nutrition, (3) Agriculture and Industry, (4) Rural and Urban Development, (5) Science and Technology, (6) Skill Development and Employment, (7) Clean and Green Energy and (8) Economy and Finance. A total of 8 sectoral experts will be appointed as consultants.

Ministers of Planning, Finance, Social Welfare, Education, Health, Agriculture. Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Urban Development and Information Technology (IT & BT) departments will be special invitees in this institution.

The Additional Chief Secretary to Government – Planning, Programme Monitoring and Statistics Department will be the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of SITK. Chief Secretary to Government, Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner, Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretary/Secretaries of Planning, Finance, Social Welfare, Education, Health, Agriculture, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Urban Development and Information Technology (IT & BT) Departments are other official members.

SITK will have around 14 eminent Government and Non-Government Institutions, viz., (1) Karnataka Innovative Authority, (2) Fiscal Policy Institute, (3) Karnataka State Labor Institute, (4) Environmental Management and Policy Research Institute, (5) Administrative Training Institute, Mysore, (6) Abdul Nazir Saab State Institute for Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Mysore, (7) State Institute of Urban Development, Mysore, (8) Administrative Reforms – II, (9) Karnataka State Council for Science and Technology (10) Knowledge Commission, (11) Indian Institute of Science (IISc), (12) Indian Institute of Management -Bangalore (IIMB), (13) National Law School of India University (NLSIU)-Bengaluru and (14) Institute for Social and Economic Change (ISEC), who will be partner institutions. Apart from that, it is proposed to attach existing divisions of Planning Department to support the SITK i.e District Planning Division, Karnataka Evaluation Authority, Technical Division, Library and Publication and Administrative Division, for secretariat support. On the lines of Development Monitoring and Evaluation Office (DMEO) of NITI Aayog, Karnataka Evaluation Authority (KEA) would be renamed as Karnataka Monitoring and Evaluation Authority (KMEA).

Ten technical divisions namely agriculture, education, industry, rural and urban development, economic and social, health and nutrition, clean and green energy, science and technology, skill development and employment and economy and finance will be set up.

II. The main objectives of the establishment of the State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka are:

- As an advanced resource hub, reducing regional imbalances, implementing good governance practices, promoting innovation and knowledge based on monitoring and evaluation for evidence-based policy making, formulating state plans aligned with the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals – 2030 and India@2047.
- Planning and budget preparation of the state government in accordance with the
 priorities of the state, which is aimed at Nava Karnataka to significantly contribute
 to Nava Bharat.
- 3. Improving the State's contribution to the country's growth by increasing the Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP) by effective governance, sustainable use of natural resources, infrastructure development, improving the performance of government business processes and human resources.

III. Roles / Functions of State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka:

- To undertake research and innovation (proof of concept) activities as required to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals Vision (SDGs Vision- 2030) and India@2047.
- ii. Promote cooperative local governance which encompasses planning at State/district/Taluka/ GP level.
- iii. Strengthening Grama Panchayat Development Plan (GPDP) through efficient utilization and participation of local resources.

- iv. Enhancing the State's Gross State Domestic Product by collaborating with various stakeholders such as government, private, civil society, international experts, practitioners and corporations.
- To select aspirational Districts/Taluks/Gram Panchayats and raise them to the state average.
- vi. Provide platform for integration and resolution of inter-sectoral/ interdepartmental issues to promote integrated and inclusive development policy
- Monitoring the progress and effectiveness of all government programmes and designing policy frameworks and initiatives.
- viii. To rank districts/taluks on various important sectors like health, education, governance, livelihood, environment, etc. to boost competition amongst them and promote efficiency through financial incentives.

The Government has scrutinized the above proposal and ordered as follows.

Government Order No: PDS 47 SPB 2021, Bangalore, Dated: 06.08.2022.

In view of the points outlined in the proposal, the Government of Karnataka has approved for the reconstitution of Karnataka State Policy and Planning Commission on the line of NITI Aayog as State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka (SITK), which is aimed at Nava Karnataka contribute significantly to Nava Bharat. Approved organizational structure of SITK is given in Annexure 1.

According to this organizational structure, the Hon'ble Chief Minister is the Chairman of the State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka and an expert in government planning and related matters will be nominated by the Government as the Vice Chairman.

Ministers of Planning, Finance, Social Welfare, Education, Health, Agriculture, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Urban Development and Information Technology (IT & BT) departments are special invitees in this institution.

On the lines of NITI Aayog, a total of 8 sectoral experts will be appointed as consultants in education, health and nutrition, agriculture and industry, rural and urban development, science and technology, skill development and employment, clean and green energy and economy and finance sectors to focus on SDG - 2030 and India @2047 goals.

Ten technical divisions, namely agriculture, education, industry, rural and urban development, economic and social, health and nutrition, clean and green energy, science and technology, skill development and employment and economy and finance will be set up.

The Additional Chief Secretary to Government – Department of Planning, Programme Monitoring and Statistics as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO). To guide/advise consultants, 8 subject experts will be nominated by the Government in the areas of : (1) Poverty

Eradication, (2) Income, Food and Nutrition Security, (3) Simplification of Services, (4) Clean and green energy, (5) resource management, (6) gender equality, (7) industrial and infrastructure innovation, and (8) skill development.

SITK will have around 14 eminent Government and Non-Government Institutions, viz., (1) Karnataka Innovative Authority, (2) Fiscal Policy Institute, (3) Karnataka State Labor Institute, (4) Environmental Management and Policy Research Institute, (5) Administrative Training Institute, Mysore, (6) Abdul Nazir Saab State Institute for Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Mysore, (7) State Institute of Urban Development, Mysore, (8) Administrative Reforms – II. (9) Karnataka State Council for Science and Technology (10) Knowledge Commission, (11) Indian Institute of Science (IISc), (12) Indian Institute of Management - Bangalore (IIMB), (13) National Law School of India University (NLSIU)-Bengaluru and (14) Institute for Social and Economic Change (ISEC), who serve as partner institutions.

The existing divisions of Planning Department such as District Planning Division, Karnataka Evaluation Authority, Technical Division, Library and Publication and Administrative Division are attached to SITK. On the lines of Development Monitoring and Evaluation Office (DMEO) of NITI Aayog, Karnataka Evaluation Authority (KEA) is renamed as Karnataka Monitoring and Evaluation Authority (KMEA).

To accomplish goals of State Institute for Transformation of Karnataka (SITK) through its effective functioning under the chairman of SITK-Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka, an annual budget of 150 crores per annum and merger of funds allocated under Challenge Fundof Administrative Reforms, Karnataka Monitoring and Evaluation Authority, Innovation Fundof Karnataka Innovation Authority, Centre for Open Data Research (CODR), Sustainable Development Goals Coordination Centre (SDGCC) into SITK budget, will be effectively utilized.

This order is issued with the approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka.


